

COVID-19 SAFETY AND SANITATION MEASURES

We want to reassure you that the health and safety of our patrons, artists and staff is a top priority. The Winter Park Playhouse has implemented the following measures to ensure a safe and sanitary environment.

- 1. **Permasafe:** The entire building (lobby, theatre, bar, restrooms, door handles, etc.) and all walls and surfaces have been treated with a product called Permasafe which is approved by the CDC and kills 99.9% of germs/viruses on contact.
- 2. **UV Lights in A/C Units:** All seven of the building's air conditioning units have Germicidal UV lights installed. These lights work in conjunction with the filtration systems to optimize indoor air quality and neutralize pathogens, viruses, bacteria, mildew, and mold.
- 3. **Raised stage:** The old 6" theatre stage has been removed and a new, 18" high stage has been installed. This provides a safer distance between artists and patrons.
- 4. **Face coverings**: Masks are available for any patron who wishes to wear one. They were required for two years and are currently optional.
- 5. **Cleaning:** Cleaning and disinfecting of all public and non-public areas with an electrostatic fogger and hospital grade, non-toxic cleaner will occur before and after each performance.
- 6. **Touchless fixtures:** Touchless faucets and soap dispensers have been installed in all restrooms and touchless hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the building.

The Winter Park Playhouse's health policy is subject to change per Actors' Equity Association union requirements and/or CDC, local, state, and federal laws.
